Seed Lube #2 (Talc) is ideal for use on newer style air planters. The Talc will coat the seeds in the planter box, also reducing equipment wear. Seed Lube #2 is not recommended for use on the older style finger planters. Seed Lube #1 or Seed Lube #3 are better suited for those applications.
